Recently we caught one of these glimpses when the Ha Hlalele congregation arrived at the Easter Conference in a small bus. Ten years ago when we arrived in Lesotho, this congregation wasn't much more than "two or three gathered together."



The village was very resistant to the Gospel, and the few who did get saved faced great persecution. A spiritual breakthrough took place when several young men got saved. In spite of the persecution, they stood strong, fasted, prayed, and witnessed effectively. Many were touched by their lives and also left all to follow Jesus. Even a leader from the Catholic church was gloriously saved! How exciting to see this dilapidated coach arrive Easter Sunday morning with all the seats full and more people standing in the aisles—probably more than 35 people!

## Kaitlyn & Kristell's Korner




I'm in first grade now! I enjoy it, but it's harder than kindergarten. After school in the afternoon I play with Thabiso.
