A lot has happened since the beginning of 2015. The pictures below will give you a little update on some of the more interesting activities.




In January, HIM helped more than 80 orphans and vulnerable children with school supplies, uniforms, and school fees.


Twenty-six people were baptized in the river not too far from Matukeng. It is always so rewarding to see the results of a year's worth of ministry at these annual baptism services!
